# A Visit to Sports Car Classics, Los Angeles



I had the pleasure of meeting
Harry Fulford, the Founder &
Proprietor of Sports Car Classics
whilst searching for a manual
gearbox for my E-Type. Of course,
Harry had the proverbial needle in
the haystack but that would not be
my last visit to Harry's shop in
Newbury Park, just north of LA.

Harry has been in the mainstream automotive business for many years, but Sports Car Classics serves the enthusiast market. His clients are those who are looking for modern performance and reliability in a vintage E-type or XJ Saloon. He says, "We aim to build Classic Jaguar Cars to an exacting standard of quality and more importantly build them to function and operate well with today's roads and traffic conditions. It is also our aim to make everything function like a new Jaguar. We offer you a professional, hassle

free service. Whether you are seeking some service work, upgrades or indeed a full restoration, we can assist you. "

I'm in the shop today to look at a couple of great projects underway. The first is a black 1974 XKE Roadster that is undergoing a full service and installation of a modern aluminum radiator and high performance fan assemblies. The new radiator allows for greater cooling capacity also includes fitting points for a modern parallel ac condenser. Coupled with a brand new aluminum A6 compressor, this will be a cool cat.

The second car is a 1975 XJ12C that is one of Harry's signature projects. This car has been completely stripped, painted with







a gorgeous shade of metallic blue and reassembled with a 1996 6.0L V12 and Tremec TKO 550. The late model V12 block features a one piece rear main seal (no rope seal!) and has been bored and stroked to 7.4L. The car is fitted with the only set of tubular headers that I have ever seen in a V12 Saloon...

His best work is the fuel injection conversion with his proprietary crank triggered ignition system. The fuel injection system features modified intake manifolds, large throttle bodies, larger injectors and an Emerald programmable ECU which controls fuel and timing. Alternatively, you can choose a system that uses throttle bodies that looks like Weber 45's. These are for the six cylinders or V12.

Using his skills and experience,
Harry can tune the fuel and
advance curves with a laptop for
maximum drivability and
performance. No more flooding or
vapor lock! Greater efficiency and
power means no more exhaust
smell either. Cars can be ordered
with catalysts so the tailpipe



emissions area as good as your daily driver.





# Mullin Tour and Waterside Luncheon

The Mullin Automotive Museum of Oxnard California was founded by Peter Mullin and houses some of his collection of French art deco designed vehicles featuring Bugatti and several other Marques. Mr Mullin is Also Chairman of the famed Peterson Automotive Museum in Los Angeles and is the President of the American Bugatti Club. In addition to the vehicles there are also displays of art deco period furniture, sculptures and graphic art pieces.

On Saturday August 10th some 35 JOCLA members and their guests attended a fascinating Docent led tour of the Mullin Automotive Museum and a group Lunch dockside in Oxnard CA. Some attendees arrived in Oxnard the night before the tour and made a weekend out of it. The group of attendees was large enough that it had to be broken into two segments, each led by a Docent well versed in the history of both the museum itself as well as



the automobiles on display.

One of the Docents, a former Jaguar marketing employee delighted our group with his technical knowledge about the vehicles as well as fascinating anecdotes about the cars and their history including instances regarding previous owners. We saw different types of cars ranging from Citroen 2CVs to Bugattis, Delahayes, and Peugots. The age range of the autos on display include examples all the way back to the Brass Age and up to the early 1990s. Included in the vehicle displays were ½ dozen unrestored pre- World War II Bugattis that were from the Schlumpf collection.

Another area of the museum housed ten race cars some of which are active in historic racing events today. The group also had the opportunity to view the other art deco works on display.

Following the museum tour, the JOCLA members gathered at the Waterside Café and Wine Bar for an Al Fresco lunch. The day proved so enjoyable for our group that some of us did not depart from the Waterside until 3pm.

If you are not familiar with IDYLLWILD California it's a quaint forest village nestled in the San Bernardino mountains just above HEMET California. Unlike other mountain resorts in the area, BIG BEAR and LAKE ARROWHEAD, IDYLLWILD is a retreat, a creative environment and artists retreat. Annual music festivals are held there along with conferences on literature, dance, and philosophy. You hear only mountain sounds there with an occasional wildlife song. This is an idyllic location for peace and the appreciation of the arts and fine dining too.

The INLAND EMPIRE JAGUAR CLUB, Mike Zavos President, choose this spot for the above reasons and it continues to please and entertain members from the South West Jaguar Clubs. This JCNA Concours usually attracts the Best of the Best after an active concours season. The cars that come to this show are mostly those in national or regional contention and high scores are not unusual and the best judges are always there to provide inscrutable scrutiny. The IEJC JCNA Concours is the last leg of the three shows required for JCNA National and Regional ranking and this year's show provided some of the closet competition I have seen in many years. There were three 100 point scored cars, I reviewed them myself and could not find fault in any of them. Two modern cars and one 2-year total restoration, unbelievable detail on all three, and their previous scores support their results.

This year's field of cars was no exception, participating cars were mostly in the 99.85-100.00 scores over the season. The quality of the restorations and maintenance was just as impressive, authentic finishes, not over polished, documentation available, and electrics without the LUCAS curse. Mike Zavos, IEJC President, did a terrific

job promoting the annual event and providing a wonderful awards dinner at FERRO Italian restaurant, Mikes organizational skills just get better every year. He provides a tasty spread of munchies and liquids for the judges and snacks for everyone in attendance. The hospitality cabin was always busy with folks enjoying the selection of drinks and eats. Mike also does a great job with his raffle's prizes from MOSS MOTORS, PEP BOYS, HARBOR FREIGHT, and XKS MOTORSPORTS.

Chief Judge, Charlie Hallums, did his usual job of confirming the judge's qualifications and assignments, Ed Sowell was not there but his computer program CONCOURS BUILDER was there organizing the classes,

judge's assignments, 15 minute judging schedules, including breaks and lunch too. All went well, no glitches, everyone reported to their cars when it was their turn to be judged. The biggest issue this year was ORIGINAL and NON-AUTHENTIC proof and acknowledgement. The JCNA AUTHENTICITY MANUALS were in good use this year and I believe this was because the quality of the cars was so high that the judges were taking a second and third look at these wonderful examples that were on the field. The competition was that close, if you were there you would be hard pressed to find fault with many of the cars, I think this might be a trend with more modern cars participating, as the field was at least 85% modern cars.

The wonderful thing about this event is that it is an example of how several clubs share the responsibilities of running and organizing a concours and the event

in general. The Jaguar Owners Club Los Angeles, San Diego Jaguar Club, Inland Empire Jaguar Club members made this event successful, IEJC

organized the venue and participant events, JOCLA



organized the Concours and judging, SDJC helped with the social events at the restaurants, and everyone who attended went away with


a sense of family and comradery. My thanks to the Clubs for putting on a terrific event and for their efforts to maintain the high standards that is




